Directions:

From Birmingham

- Take I-20 East to Exit 152, turn left at the end of the exit ramp. Go under the interstate and turn left on the first road past the ramp. The camp sign "WorldSong" is at the entrance.

From Anniston

- Take I-20 West to Exit 152, turn right at the end of the ramp and then an immediate left at camp sign, "WorldSong"
