The Alabama Challenge Team is made up of Acteens or teen girls who live our theme verse.

“If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. We are so excited you'd like to apply for the Alabama Challenge Team! Your commitment will run September through August of your application year and you'll be expected to fulfill the responsibilities and maintain the principles of Christ-like behavior and responsible citizenship that we hold to. Please review the requirements below and feel free to call me (my contact information is listed below) if you have any questions!

To be eligible for the Alabama Challenge Team girls must...

- Be entering the 10th grade or 15 years old by September 1st
- Be an active member of a local Acteens or Girls Ministry group and an active member of a Southern Baptist Church in Alabama.
- Agree to serve from September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2018. Team members are required to attend the Challenge Team Retreat in November and the Complete Conference in March. They are also highly encouraged to attend the Emerging Leaders forum in July.
- Submit your application to Alabama WMU by the application deadline, May 1, 2017. **Only fully completed applications will be considered.**

Alabama Acteens Advisors or Adult Leaders will be asked to support their Alabama Challenge Team member by:

1. Providing her with Christ like love, support and encouragement.
2. Assisting her in setting up speaking engagements.
3. Helping her prepare for speaking engagements and/or church/association events.
All Challenge Team members will be eligible for a missions involvement scholarship for up to \$150.00 during their year of service.

To Apply, Girls:

1. Must complete application and write paragraphs describing (please type paragraphs):
 - A) “How I Became A Christian and How I Have Grown as a Christian During the Past Year”
 - B) “Why Acteens or Girls’ Ministry is Important to Me” (if applicable)
 - C) “Why I Want to Serve on the Alabama Challenge Team.”
 - D) “An idea for a conference to be offered at *COMPLETE*.”
2. Must send Malory Ford (Alabama WMU Student Consultant) a link to their social media accounts (facebook, twitter, Instagram, etc.) and accept her friend request so that she can determine that their social media presence is edifying to the Lord and correlates to Alabama WMU’s values and commitments.
3. **Must have completed application to Alabama WMU no later than May 1, 2017.** Applications must include **most recent and clearest passport size photo**, parent’s signature, Acteens or Girls’ Ministry Advisor/Director’s signature, and requested paragraphs.

Only fully completed applications will be considered.
